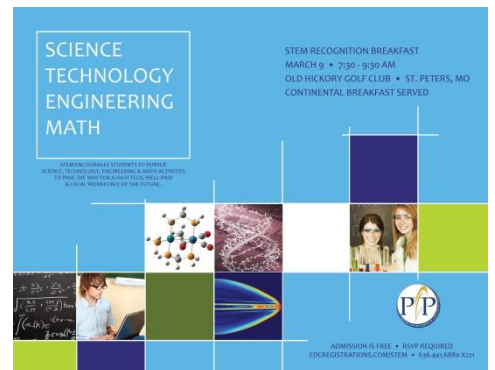
Public and private high schools in St. Charles County have until Feb. 8th to nominate students for this year's recognition awards based on their participation in STEM along with their college and career plans.
